

Old Santa Fe Trail Morrow Bowden Architects

A 4,000 square foot home and gallery for art collectors, Natalie and Irving Forman. The house is located in the Historic District of Old Santa Fe Trail and illustrates how a contemporary building can fit comfortably in the district. A large steel trellis mimics a traditional beamed porch structure. Customary stuccoed walls, separating the residence from Old Santa Fe Trail, were extended to enclose a series of walled courtyards.
