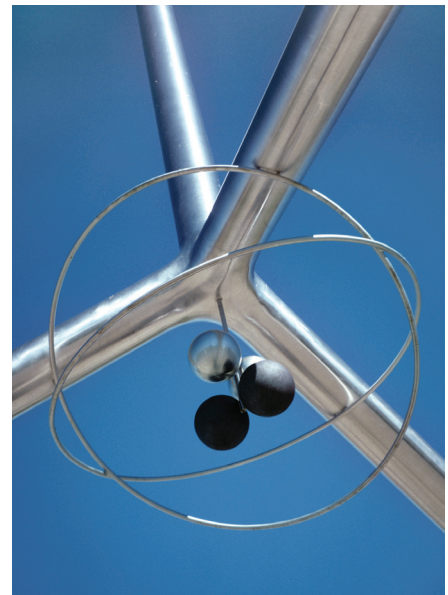




Robert B. Gaylor IDSA, Principal
